COVID Policy Additions:

A COVID release waiver is included at the end of this Registration Form. Here are a few of the precautions we will be enforcing for the weekend:

- Masks will be expected to be worn during specific parts of the weekend, to be outlined in full prior to the weekend and enforced by all retreat leaders. PLEASE PACK A MASK
- If your child is feeling ill or may have been exposed, according to CDC guidelines, please keep them home (we know it would be a bummer to miss out on the weekend, so please be careful prior to the retreat.)
- Temperatures will be taken at check-in by your Youth Director or Church Volunteers. Any temperatures 100.4 or above will require your child to stay home.
- By signing below, in addition to the listed medical protocols, you are also agreeing to allow the nurses and retreat coordinators to decide whether your child may need to be quarantined for a portion of the weekend or sent home.

Your signature acknowledges that your child may need to be picked-up from the weekend should the nurses and retreat coordinators deem it necessary.

General Regulations

- Campers may not leave the grounds or use cars at any time during the retreat, except by permission of the retreat director.
- Attendance at all meals and sessions is mandatory.
- Registration must be made through your church prior to arrival at Tuscarora.
- There will be absolutely NO alcohol, drugs, tobacco, knives, or fireworks.
- NO boys in girls' rooms and NO girls in boys' rooms.
- Cheerful observance of all retreat regulations is expected.
- Those who do not comply with retreat regulations may be asked to leave the grounds if the staff deems it necessary.
- Campers who are caught outside after lights out will have their parents called immediately. Parents of campers who do not comply with the rules will be notified to pick up their campers.
- Program participation requires full-time registration.

Cell Phone and Electronics Regulations

Electronic equipment including, but not limited to cell phones, electronic tablets, smart watches, computers, and MP3 players are strictly prohibited for the following reasons:

- Cell phones pose a liability. The ease of taking and distributing inappropriate photos, even without the owner's consent, poses a legal risk.
- Electronic devices are expensive and are at risk of being damaged or stolen.
- Cell phones, iPods, and other electronic devices are a distraction from the relational and spiritual components the weekend is intended to foster.

Campers are required to turn in their phones to their youth leaders before the start of camp. Phones will be kept in a secure location and will be available to campers for emergencies. Should a parent wish to contact their child, the parent may call one of their church's youth leaders, or Tuscarora's main office: 570- 897-6000. Campers' cell phones will be returned at the end of the weekend after their belongings are packed and their rooms are left orderly.

Waiver of Liability

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

Assumption of Risk

Guest expressly understands and agrees that Guest's use of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises presents known and inherent risks to Guest regarding any potential and/or actual infection of Covid-19 and/or any related illness, the result of which may be both serious and minor, including but not limited to, cough, fever, pneumonia, hospitalization, and death. Guest is responsible for evaluating the risks that he or she may face. Guest has done so, and has assumed the risks and is responsible for his or her actions.

Guest further recognizes, understands, and agrees that Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center assumes no responsibility for any liability, damage, or injury relating to or resulting from Covid-19 that may be caused by the negligent, grossly negligent, or willful acts or omissions committed prior to, during, or after use of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises by Guest.

Acknowledgment of Safety Measures Utilized by Guest and Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center

Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center hereby acknowledges that it will seek to take certain safety measures to help prevent, as best it reasonably can, infection or spread of Covid-19. Such safety measures include the following: cleaning and disinfecting publicly used spaces, wearing gloves when cleaning and disinfecting, maintaining social distancing from Guest, its employees, visitors, and Guests, and wearing face masks when in the company of Guests. Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center will also stay apprised of any recommendations of the CDC and will consider action accordingly. Further, Tuscarora may remove any safety measures listed herein once the CDC or the United States, state, or local governments deem such measures are no longer necessary. Guest acknowledges that it will also take certain safety measures to help prevent, as best it reasonably can, infection or spread of Covid-19. Such safety measures include: ensuring that Guest does not have any symptoms of Covid-19 prior to entrance onto or use of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises, use of handwashing and hand sanitizer on a regular basis while on the Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's premises, maintaining social distancing, and proper use of face masks when in the company of others. In the event that the CDC recommends additional safety measures, Guest agrees to pursue utilization of such safety measures upon verbal or written request of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless

Guest specifically understands that it is personally responsible for its actions and omissions, and any resulting sicknesses or injuries relating to or resulting from Covid-19 and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless, including from reasonable attorneys' fees and/or any other associated costs, Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center, and its predecessors, successors, assigns, officers, directors, trustees, faculty, employees, volunteers, agents, and legal representatives, from any and all actions, claims, or demands that Guest, and assigns, have or may have for any and all sicknesses or injuries relating to or resulting from Covid-19, Guest may suffer or sustain, regardless of cause or fault, as a result of his/her voluntary decision to utilize the facilities and premises of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center, caused by any act or omission of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center and/or Guest, its employees, visitors, and Guests resulting from utilizing the facilities and premises of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center.

Waiver of Claims

In consideration of being allowed to utilize Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises, Guest (referred to herein as "Releasor"), hereby waives any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, or suits, in law or in equity, whether heretofore or hereafter accruing, or whether now known or not known to the parties, which may arise from any negligent or grossly negligent act or omission of Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center, or its predecessors, successors, assigns, officers, directors, trustees, faculty, employees, volunteers, agents, or legal representatives (collectively referred to herein as "Releasees"), including but not limited to claims for negligence, gross negligence, personal injury, and mental anguish, for or because of anything done or omitted, or suffered to be done, directly or indirectly related to Guest's use of and entrance upon Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises relating to or resulting from possible or actual exposure to Covid-19. Releasor further waives any and all liability of Releasees for their negligence or gross negligence causing any accident, illness, injury, loss or damage to personal property, or any other consequences arising or resulting directly or indirectly from Guest's use of and entrance upon Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises. Releasor acknowledges and agrees that Releasees assume no responsibility for any liability, damage, or injury that may be caused by the negligent, grossly negligent, or willful acts or omissions committed prior to, during, or after Guest's use of and entrance upon Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center's facilities and premises. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: *What is Junior High Winter Weekend?*

A: Junior High Winter Weekend is a winter retreat hosted by the Lutheran Brethren Youth Fellowship (an association of LB youth groups) at Tuscarora Inn and Conference Center in Mt. Bethel, PA.

Q: *What will my child be doing at Winter Weekend?*

A: The entire weekend is centered on connecting with God and connecting with one another. Your child will be participating in group games and tournaments, eating meals together, and spending quality time with peers (real, face-to-face time using actual words—no texts or emojis!). Additionally, campers will be encouraged to deepen their understanding of God through relevant, biblical messages given by the speaker throughout four sessions, as well as small group discussion times facilitated by their youth group leaders.

Q: *What should campers bring for the weekend?*

A: ***At least one cloth facemask*** Clothing (check the forecast!), including PJs, clothes for basketball, volleyball, or tubing if there is snow; towels and toiletries; Bible and notebook; and sleeping bag/blanket and pillow if not renting bedding from Tuscarora. Campers may wish to bring a small amount of spending money for snacks and souvenirs.

Q: *What is the cost for the weekend?*

A: The cost for the weekend is \$145 (\$150 if you would like Tuscarora to provide bedding). This cost covers all meals, lodging and program fees.

Q: *When does the weekend begin and end?*

A: Junior High Winter Weekend will begin the evening of Friday, January 15th and end after lunch on Sunday, January 17th. Please check with your youth director to find out what time your group will be meeting on Friday and returning home on Sunday afternoon.

Q: *What should I do if my child has a specific medical need?*

A: Please make your youth director aware of any medical needs prior to the weekend. If your child has dietary restrictions, they will need to indicate those on the registration form *and* alert their Youth Leader. Your Youth Leader can direct you to Tuscarora's online Dietary Restrictions Form. Campers must hand all medications (including over-the-counter medications) to their Youth Leader before the weekend begins. One or more registered nurses will be available throughout the weekend should any medical issues arise.

Q: *What should I do if my child has to be picked up early?*

A: We encourage campers to make arrangements to stay the entire weekend. In the event that your child needs to leave early, please alert your youth director and plan to pick up and drop off your child at Tuscarora's main office—not your child's room.
