We feel a child's first school experience ought to be filled with positive memories and lasting value. We provide a Christian atmosphere of respect and loving appreciation for each person and for the wonders of God's world. Each child is encouraged to progress at his/her own rate of speed while enjoying enriching experiences, gaining self discipline and learning to make worthwhile choices.

The curriculum at Little Friends is Christ centered. The children will learn that they are special because a loving God created them, loves them and sent His Son, Jesus, to be their best friend and Savior. Each child is taught that he/she is uniquely designed by God and that He has a special purpose in life for each of them.
